Charts can be annotated, saved and even printed – and best of all, no Internet connection is required, just a simple audio connection to your short-wave receiver.

For more sophisticated use, Board Terminal provides automatic control of your HF receiver, unattended fax monitoring and de-coding, and a built-in frequency database allowing extremely simple operation. Board Terminal costs just £299 inc VAT.
